- ◆ Our stimulus project will likely be Davis Road – R&R with asphalt overlay

- ◆ Davis Road is a major connector between Douglas/A.P. and I-10 for truck traffic
 - ADT is about 1600
 - Serves as route for oversize loads





- ◆ SAFETEA-LU earmark of \$2.6 M to fix several spot drainage problems and realign some curves
 - Construction contract in about a year
 - The environmental clearance has taken twice as long as expected









- ◆ Cochise is still seeing development proposals, but it has slowed down
- ◆ Allows for some planning efforts
 - Working on new Subdivision Regulations
 - Joint transportation plan with City of Benson and ADOT for the NW section of County
 - New traffic modeling program

- ◆ Span wire traffic signal in partnership with developers and ADOT
 - ◆ Already bid
- ◆ Palominas drainage project
 - 📁 Channel (<\$300K) Spring bid
 - 📄📁 Culverts (<\$1 Mil) Summer bid
